PREVIEW:

This is it. After a thrilling opening night and a summer full of ups and downs the Keys bring its 21st season to a close today in Wilmington, DE. Frederick's hopes of posting a .500 half came to a close yesterday with an 8-1 loss.

Robbie Widlansky will put his grasp on the league's batting title today. Since joining the Keys on May 19th from extended spring training Widlansky has surprised to become a force in Frederick's everyday lineup. Even though he will come 10-15 plate appearances short of the 378 needed his .345 average is easily enough to garner the honor once prorating his average out to the 378 plate appearances needed. He will be the first Key since Rick Short in 1997 and the fourth ever to win the honor.

Sean Gleason will do the honors making the final start of 2009. First pitch is scheduled for 1:05 PM. Coverage will begin on the Frederick Keys Baseball Network with the UPS Store Pregame Show at 12:45 PM.

BLUE ROCKS: Alex Caldera (5-10, 4.99)

- Has rebounded in the second half to go 4-5 with a 3.67 ERA.
- Had the highest ERA for a starting pitcher in the league in June going 0-5 with a 7.77 ERA.
- Was a dominant force in Class-A Burlington in 2008 going 12-6 with a 2.89 ERA.

KEYNOTES:

KEYS SWEEP AWARDS... Brandon Waring was named Most Valuable Player and Zach Britton Pitcher of the Year by the Carolina League. Waring is the first MVP in the 21-year history of the Keys. The Keys slugger hit 26 home runs and drove home 90 on the year. He is tied for second in Keys history for home runs in a season and is the first Key to drive home 90 runs since 1997. Britton was stellar going 9-6 with a 2.70 ERA with Frederick in 2009. The lone starter to spend the entire season in the Keys rotation, Britton currently third in the league in ERA, second in strikeouts (131) and fourth in innings pitched (140). Outfielder Matt Angle and Catcher Caleb Joseph were also named to the Post Season All Star Team.

WIDLANSKY PLAYER OF THE MONTH... On his way to the Carolina League batting title, Robbie Widlansky picked up some more hardware earning the nod as Carolina League Player of the Month for August. Widlansky led the circuit for a second time in three months, batting .356 in August. He also drove home 22 runs in 29 games. The Orioles 11th round pick in 2007 out of Florida Atlantic, Widlansky led the league in batting in June hitting a cool .395.

ATTAINABLE GOAL... The Keys are looking to end the half at or above the .500 mark for the first time since the second half of the 2006 season. Frederick has had five consecutive losing halves, even though it has won the league title in that time. Frederick qualified for the 2007 playoffs with a 32-37 first half record, winning the downtrodden north.

- Joins younger brother Zach on Keys becoming first pair of brothers ever to play for Frederick together.
- Played at NAIA Lubbock Christian University where he was one of three players drafted in 2008 on team that went 53-4.
- Frederick is fourth different affiliate he has suited up with in 2009.

Cash, David OF [40th Rd 2006, Odessa, FL]

- Cash attended the University of Florida.
- His father Dave played in the Major Leagues for more than ten seasons.
- He was selected in the 40th round of the 2006 draft.

Crancer, Wally C [12 Rd 2007, Norco, CA]

- Attended Georgia Tech but resides in Norco, CA.
- Played catcher for the first time in his career in 2008.
- He went to the same college as Keys standout Matt Wieters.

Joseph, Caleb C [7th Rd 2008, Franklin, TN]

- Joseph resides in Franklin, TN.
- He attended Lipscomb University in Nashville.
- His brother, Corban, was also drafted in 2008 by the Yankees.

Hudson, Kyle OF [4th Rd 2008, Mattoon, IL]

- A wide receiver, led Illinois in pass receptions his freshman and sophomore seasons.

- Family friends with long time St. Louis Cardinals manager Whitey Herzog.
- Britton was selected in the third round of the 2006 draft.
- Pitched for Delmarva in 2008 and racked up 114 strikeouts.

Cooney, Brandon **RHP** **[30th Rd. 2007, Hollywood, FL]**

- Registered 16 saves in 37 appearances with Class-A Delmarva in 2009 as its closer.
- Is third Florida Atlantic Owl to play with Frederick in 2009 along with IF/OF Robbie Widlansky and LHP Chris Salberg.
